

# What to Send for a Design Review

Send as much of this as you have. The more complete the set, the quicker and more useful the review.

Current as at September 2026

## Plans

- ☐ **Floor plans** for every level.
- ☐ **Roof plan** showing pitch, material, vents, skylights and flues.
- ☐ **Elevations** (all four).
- ☐ **Site plan** with a north point, boundaries and neighbouring buildings or trees.
- ☐ **Electrical layout**, if one exists yet, including switchboard location.

## About the project

- ☐ **Project stage**: concept, developed design, consent, or under construction.
- ☐ **Timeline** and any deadlines (consent lodgement, tender, framing).
- ☐ **Who else is involved**: designer, builder, electrician, engineer.
- ☐ **Known constraints**: covenants, heritage, wind zone, shading concerns.

## What the owner wants

- ☐ **Solar now, later, or just “ready”**.
- ☐ **Battery**: now, later or not at all.
- ☐ **EV charging**, current or planned.
- ☐ **Major loads**: heat pumps, hot water type, pool or spa, workshop.
- ☐ **Anything specific** to check.
